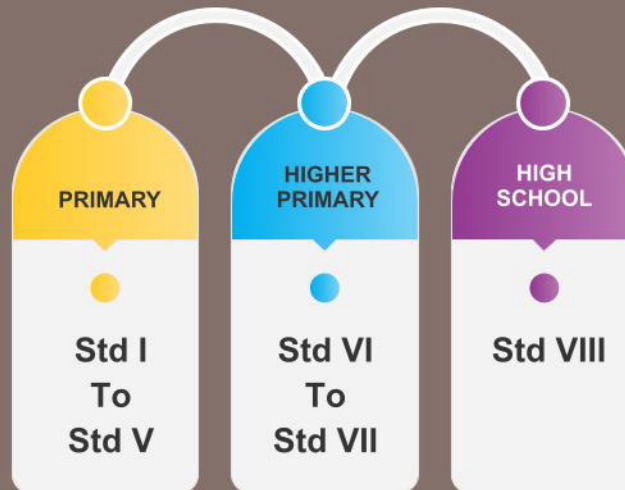

Since the institution is unaided, the fee structure may be revised from time to time to meet the additional expenditure such as staff and increment, equipment etc.,

No child will be allowed to appear for the Terminal or Final examination unless all the dues are paid. Special fees like, Examination Fee, Sports Fee, Medical Fee, Annual Fee and Reading Room Fee are also collected.

Under no circumstances the fees once paid will be refunded. Fee for the entire term has to be paid even if the child attends only a part of the term. In their own interest, children are advised not to be absent for any test or examination. In case of absent no re-examination will be conducted.



FACILITIES OF THE SCHOOL

1 Smart Class:



Visual and virtual learning is a matter of common approach in the modern education system. A child learns better when he looks at the original picture and listens to a well developed lecture on the subject. Therefore, the school is planning to install smart class to help students learn better and in easier way. This will make learning fun-filled and keeps the children away from the monotonous boredom.

2 Merit Awards

Merit Prizes based on the performance of pupils (class wise) after the final examination are given every year.



3 Computer Lab

Computer Education



Computer has dominated the human world. Each and everyone in this world has become computer wizard. Today each and every school has introduced computer education to help students keep in pace with the growing Hi-tech world. Similarly, **LION'S SAWMY VIVEKANANDA ENGLISH MEDIUM PRIMARY & HIGH SCHOOL** has also installed a hi-tech computer lab to help students avail practical knowledge. As it is an extra programme for the students, a lump sum amount will be charged as Computer fee from the students of Class I and above.



4 Activities

CO-CURRICULAR AND CLUB ACTIVITIES

Literary activities such as debate, quiz, essay writing, drawing, music, sports, athletics and team games are held section wise. Competitions are conducted every year and prizes are awarded to the winners.

Pupils good in the activities will be sent to participate in competitions organised by the Education Department and others.

All the pupils should compulsorily participate in the competitions. Various clubs are introduced to enhance the leadership quality of the pupils.



5 HOUSE SYSTEM

To develop competitive spirit and leadership quality among the students. They are divided into 4 Houses. Namely

Red House

Green House

Blue House

Yellow House

Leaders are chosen for each house to help in maintaining discipline in the school.



6 LIBRARY AND READING ROOM:

Library containing reference books, subject books, Children's Encyclopedia, General knowledge, Story books, Moral education, etc, of different levels is maintained. More than 3500 Books are available in the Library. News papers and magazines are also made available. During leisure, Library hours pupils are expected to make use of the same. Every pupil is expected to read atleast 10 books every year. They must make note in the diary, the titles of the books they have read.



7 EXCURSIONS/ OUTINGS

Pupils are taken out to historical places or other places of interest. Outings to nearby garden places for the lower classes will be organized. All pupils are expected to participate in such trips whenever arranged.





8 SPORTS AND LITERARY COMPETITIONS:

All pupils should compulsorily participate in sports & literary activities and participate in competitions. All the students should utilize the opportunity for practicing the games they are interested in.



9 SELF STUDY TIME TABLE:

Pupils of Middle and High school should prepare self study, home time- table and get the same scrutinized by the class teachers. Parents should see that the pupils follow them at home and develop systematic study habits. A model of the same is given at the end of the diary.

11 SOCIAL SERVICE ACTIVITIES:

With a view to instill in the pupils a spirit of service to the needy and to develop a fellow feeling, they are given chances to participate in the distribution of fruits etc. to the inmates of the orphanages and patients in hospitals on the day of National importance (eg. 2nd Oct.). They should become the members of social service club and participate in club activities.

12 COMMUNICATION SKILLS:

To develop communicative abilities, students are required to write letters to class teachers, relatives and parents in English.

13 STUDENT COMMITTEES:

To inculcate leadership qualities, to kindle a sense of responsibility, explore latent talents, student committees will be formed not only to maintain discipline but also to plan, organize and conduct various competitions and functions.

14 PARENT'S OPEN DAY:

To have cordial relationship between the Parents and the Teachers, meetings are arranged regularly to share the views for the development of the children on open days.



15 PARENT'S DAY:

A unique activity of Parents Sports and Culture is introduced to recall their school days. Various competitions are conducted and prizes are distributed.

17 STUDENT BUS FACILITY:

For the safe conveyance of the pupils from home to school and back, Bus facility is provided by the school. Interested parents may make use of this facility for the pupils.



18 IDENTITY CARD:

Identity card is very important for the students. Thus, each student irrespective of the class, is issued an identity card by the school. Students must keep the card intact with them when they come to school. It is also one important element of the school uniform.



REMEDIAL CLASSES:

The School provides remedial classes on regular basis considering the children come from different family backgrounds with different living standards. There are children with high learning ability who can grasp quite fast and learn better but there are children who need frequent guidance and support.

ADMISSION & WITHDRAWAL:

The admission will be purely based on merit. However, students of Class Nursery, LKG & UKG will be give direct admission without any admission test. The decision of the Principal in the regard will be final and binding.

In the case of withdrawal, a written application to the effect must be submitted to the Principal a month in advance. However, such applications are always expected at the end of academic session.

CHECKLIST OF DOCUMENTS:

The following documents need to be submitted at school during admission.

- 1) Original Transfer/School Leaving Certificate from the previous school
- 2) Aadhar Card.
- 3) 2 stamp Size photographs of the child.
- 4) 1 each stamp sized photograph of mother, father and local guardian.

EXTRA CURRICULAR PROGRAMME:

Several skills and qualities that are instrumental to a child's holistic development are learnt outside the classroom. 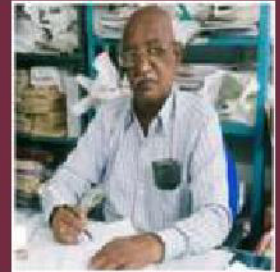
